

**REEVES COUNTY GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT
NOTICE OF HEARING
January 31, 2019**

Notice is given that the Board of Directors of the Reeves County Groundwater Conservation District (RCGCD) will hold a public hearing, accept public comment, and may take action on the adoption of proposed RCGCD's Rules regulating groundwater in Reeves County, Texas. The proposed rules address definitions; waste and beneficial use; rulemaking; emergency rules; enforcement of rules, orders and permits; registration, records and reports; permit required, permit amendments and applications; criteria for issuance and elements of permit; permits for existing wells; operating permits; maximum allowable production; permit term; timing of action on application; regulation of spacing and production; exempt wells; open or uncovered wells; transfer of groundwater out of district, meters; right to enter land; district fees; notice and hearing process; and aquifer storage and recovery projects. Changes may be made to the proposed RCGCD's Rules based upon comments received or made at the hearing, and the Rules may be adopted with or without such changes without further notice or hearing.

This rulemaking hearing will be held on Thursday, January 31, 2019, beginning at 5:00 p.m. at the Pecos Economic Development Corporation Building, 119 S. Cedar Street, Pecos, Texas.

Any person who desires to appear at the hearing and present comment or other information on the proposed RCGCD's Rules may do so in person, by counsel, or both. Comments may be presented verbally or in written form. Limits may be placed on the amount of time that each person is allowed to present verbal comments. The hearing posted in this notice may be recessed from day to day or continued where appropriate.
